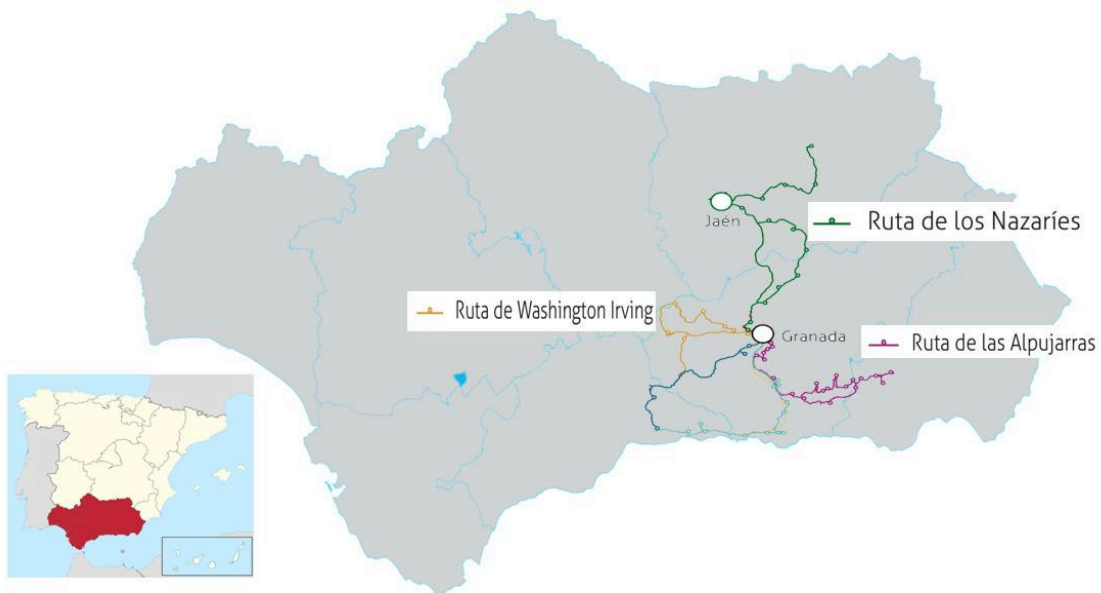




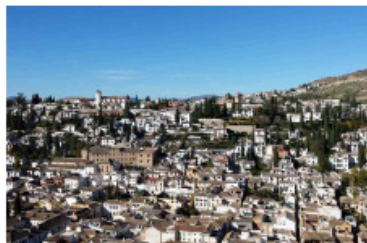
Event program from August 28 to 31

3 Circular routes with departure and arrival to Granada along the Routes of El Legado Andalusi



The Routes

Participants will be organized into groups of 50 participants. Each group will carry out a route on a different day.



Day 28

Route through the city of Granada

Historic center and neighborhood of Albaicín and Sacromonte: from the Plaza de Isabel la Católica we will walk around the Royal Chapel, Cathedral, Lonja de mercaderes, Muslim Madrasa, Corral del Carbón, Alcaicería to go up the slopes of the most emblematic neighborhood of the city, the Albaicín. Its narrow, cobbled streets will take us to the best viewpoints of Granada with the backdrop of the Alhambra and Sierra Nevada. From there we will arrive at the mythical Sacromonte neighborhood where gypsies have lived for centuries in their caves and flamenco tablaos.

Day 29

Washington Irving Route (Seville-Granada)

This Route retraces the steps that the American romantic writer and diplomat Washington Irving followed in 1829, fascinated by the wealth and exoticism of the Hispano-Arab civilization combined with admiration for the figure of Christopher Columbus and the Discovery of America that began on August 3, 1492.



Day 30

Las Alpujarras Route (Almería - Granada)

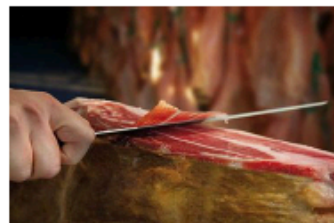

Extra Day Option August 27

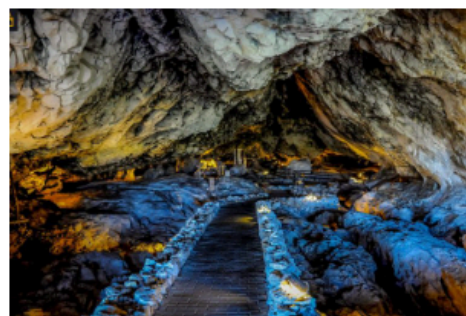
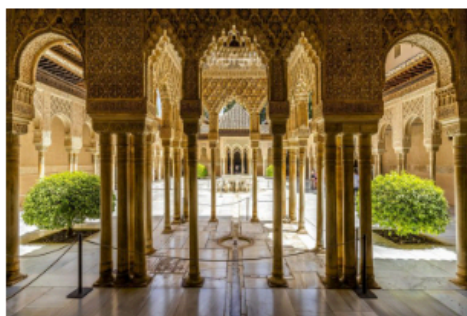
We offer you the possibility of visiting the Alhambra in Granada after a motorcycle route along the Ruta de Los Nazaríes.

Due to the high demand for tickets to visit this cultural heritage monument of humanity and the need to reserve them by name well in advance, this option must be paid directly to the organizer through the link on the registration page.

Price of this option: €65 per person.

Includes:

- Ticket for a guided tour of the Alhambra on August 27 in the afternoon. *Subject to schedule availability.
- Hotel night at Hotel Maciá Real de la Alhambra**** on August 27 + Breakfast on August 28.
- Los Nazaríes Route on August 28. (Free lunch not included)



Visit to the Alhambra

Monument declared Cultural Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO in 1984.

The Alhambra was a palatine city, Christian Royal House, General Captaincy of the Kingdom of Granada and military fortress until it was declared a Monument in 1870.

Los Nazaríes Route (Jaén-Granada)

Many of the remains of watchtowers and castles can be seen on this route, such as the towers of Torre Cardela, Iznalloz and Deifontes and the castles of Cambil, Montejícar and Píñar, in addition to the Arab baths of Jaén. The natural heritage is added to the monumental heritage. The route includes natural settings that will overwhelm the visitor, such as the Sierra Morena, Cazorla, Segura and Las Villas Natural Parks.
